

Introduction

As of October 1st 2007, new UK laws will come into effect which will ban the sale, import and manufacture of realistic imitation firearms (including all airsoft guns). An exemption has been made within these regulations for airsoft dealers within the United Kingdom to continue to be able to legally sell airsoft guns to legitimate airsoft players. These regulations specify that a legitimate airsoft player is a person who is a registered member of an accepted skirmish site - an accepted skirmish site is defined as an airsoft site that holds third party liability insurance. All sales to under 18's are now banned, by law.

Dealers who wish to continue to sell high powered, upgraded airsoft guns need to be registered firearms dealers, as all mail order and internet sales of air guns (or high powered airsoft) are now banned, which means you would need to collect from a registered dealer in person, along with proof of ID, so that they can conduct a face to face transaction.

Zero One Airsoft (zerooneairsoft.com) our parent company will get you registered and entered onto the national database within 24 working hours of becoming a member, and their new trade counter is open to visitors who wish to go and collect or look at any of their products in the flesh.

Things Made Simple at Ground Zero

Because Ground Zero is Zero One's little sister, we aim to combine our knowledge and the facilities we have available to us into a simple registration procedure which will get you membership, a photo ID card and registration with the national system all in one go.

Joining up with one of the UKs largest skirmish sites and airsoft dealer should give you the peace of mind that we have everything in hand, and that both from a site owner and retailers point of view, it is in our best interests to get you sorted as quickly and painlessly as possible in order to comply with the new regulations.

Qualify for Membership

The Home Office suggest that to qualify for site membership, you must attend no less than three games in a period of two months.

1. In the boxes on the reverse, complete all your details for our membership database. (We won't ever sell your details or pass anything onto any third party company - it's purely for the GZ membership records!)
2. When you have completed all your details, start getting your form stamped and dated when you sign-in to play for the day, within the two month time frame.
3. When you have collected your third stamp, you may hand your form in to become a member of Ground Zero. Ensure you bring the following with your form, when complete:
 - A passport sized photograph of your head & shoulders
 - £10 Annual Membership Fee
 - Completed UKARA Registration Form for the National Retailers Database (similar to this registration form)

The membership year runs from October 1 through to September 30. All memberships automatically expire on September 30th but can be renewed in which case a new Photo ID card will be issued.
